

Chapter - 3

Provision Relating to Professional Code of Conduct

3.1 Professional code of conduct : (1) For the purpose of Clause (e) of Section 9 and Clause (c) of Sub-section (1) of Section 18 of the Act, the professional code of conduct to be observed by the registered pharmacy professionalist while carrying out the pharmacy profession shall be as follows:-

(a) No discrimination be made on the basis of religion, race, sex and social caste and custom or any means against any person while exercising professional knowledge and skill.

(b) Works should be carried out only related to the subject of study or knowledge and skill obtained.

(c) No undue financial benefit of any type shall be obtained other than the remuneration, allowance and other facilities in lieu of service through publicity of pharmacy service or no undue activity of any type which damages the image of pharmacy profession be carried out or cause other to do.

(d) One should take responsibility of works done personally which are related to profession of pharmacy.

(e) Each registered pharmacy professionalist shall be required to update their name (registration).

(2) The code of conduct to be observed by the pharmacy professionalist other than as referred to in Sub-rule (1), shall be as prescribed by the Council from time to time.

(3) It shall be the duty and responsibility of all so concerned to follow or cause other to follow the professional code of conduct.

3.2 Deemed to be treated as the professional code of conduct not followed : If the registered pharmacy professionalist does not follow the code of conduct so determined in pursuant to Rule 3.1, it shall be treated that the professional code of conduct has not been followed.
